

What you will learn in your Basic Serging Class

- The basic parts of the Serger – upper looper, lower looper, etc.
- The importance of threading order – does not apply to jet-air Babylock sergers
- How to thread your serger and read your threading chart (many sergers have 16 or more possible stitches, so we will be cover 3 - 4 of the more common stitches)
- How to begin and end a serged seam
- How to thread your serger with decorative threads
- How to know where to put the decorative thread
- Uses of Decorative Flatlocking
- Using the rolled hem on your serger.
- What is differential feed and what does it do?
- Construction with the basic 4- thread stitch
- How to remove serger stitching
