

## What You Will Learn in Embroidery Class

- How to Transfer a design into your machine – We will supply the design for the class. The design will be an apple applique.
- How to mark your fabric for the design.
- The proper way to hoop your fabric and stabilizer.
- How to use the centering marks on your hoop.
- How to baste your fabric and stabilizer together in the hoop (not available on all models)
- How to move the design area in the hoop and check that the design will stitch in the proper position.
- Rotation and sizing limitations of your designs
- Adding multiple lines of Text to your design using the lettering included with your machine
- Curving and arcing of lettering (not available on all models)
- The 3 steps to successful embroidered appliqué
- How to save your design to memory for future use.
- What to do when the thread breaks
- How to go backward and forward in a design.

### **Bring the Following to Class:**

- Your sewing machine with power cord (we can assist in getting the machine to the classroom)
- Your embroidery unit and embroidery foot
- The 5" x 7" hoop or Ellisimo 8" x 8" or Pfaff 150mm x 240mm hoop
- Tear-away stabilizer to fit your hoop
- A Flat (not terry or waffle-weave) cotton kitchen towel
- Rayon or polyester embroidery thread in Red, Green, Brown and color of choice for Lettering on the towel
- A pre-wound bobbin or other bobbin with "bobbin weight" thread
- 4" square of red fabric for apple applique
- 3" square of green fabric for apple applique
- Small curved tip scissors for trimming – the ones that come with the machine will not work for our intended purpose.
