

Supply List for Lampshade Class

- Lampshade frame
either one you have (all fabric) or one you find at a second hand store OR I can supply one if you sign up for it by March 5, 2012
- Fabric – your choice, medium weight with a little give
- Lining – white or ivory crepe back satin or silk crepe de chine
- Twill tape – for wrapping top and bottom wires
- Seam binding – for wrapping ribs
- Trims – you can use self-bias trim which I will teach or you can use fringe, gimp trim with give, beaded fringe or whatever you fancy
- Clothes pin
- Upholstery needle
- Thimble
- Ball head long straight pins
- Scissors
- Dritz Dual Purpose marking pen
- Aleene's tacky glue
- Portable sewing machine for classic style shade – drum, cylinder, bell, square, oval or rectangle (used for stitching side seams)

For those interested in making a Victorian-style shade with compound curves and/or scalloped edges, please contact me so I can order a frame for you.
